

Housing is expensive

- In 2022, average rent increased more than 30% in New Jersey
- Between 2010-2020 housing costs in NJ rose over 20%, while income only increased by 2.7%
- NJ has the 3rd highest housing burden in the nation, with 29% of homeowners paying 30% or more of their income towards housing.




Population has increased by 6% in the last decade but housing stock has only increased by 3.5%




One strategy to address the housing crisis that is becoming popular across the country and within NJ is the legalization of Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs).

ADU Ordinances

- A successful ordinance ensures that ADUs are unobtrusive, but also allow enough latitude to keep construction attainable for homeowners and completed units attractive to renters.
- AARP published a <u>model local ordinance</u> that several communities, including Montclair, have used as a template.
