COVID-19 Update: <u>Bergen County</u> as of 12 pm, Tuesday, February 23, 2021 there are 67,329 Positive Cases identified as per the CDRSS system; impacting all 70 municipalities. ** As of today, 34 Long Term Care (LTC) facilities in Bergen County report at least one presumptive positive case as per the NJDOH.
