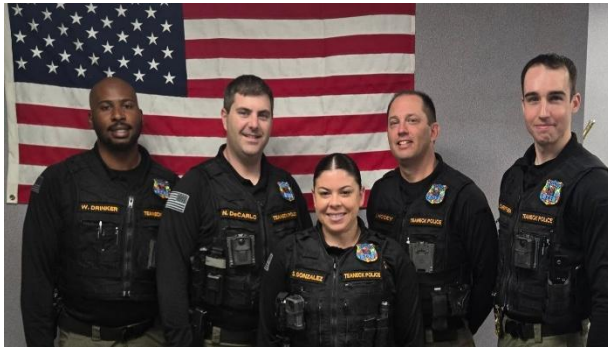

- ✓ Keep your hands on the steering wheel unless otherwise directed, even if the officer is not in your car.
- ✓ The officer may shine a flashlight in your car, may leave a note, and may have flashing lights on their car.
- ✓ When the officer gets to your car, let them know you have a blue envelope, answer the officer's questions, and ask the officer for permission before moving any parts of your body.
